

NEDC FEE SCHEDULE

The four most variable costs associated with the frozen embryo transfer with donor embryos are the home study cost, the cost of the medications, outside cycle monitoring visits and donor associated fees. Home study costs vary from state to state and from agency to agency; medication prices vary depending on your insurance coverage and your chosen pharmacy, and donor fees include lab, shipping, and handling costs paid by the NEDC to facilitate the donation of the embryos to the NEDC.

Donor associated fees are the procurement fees (shipping and labs) associated with each donor profile. This is a flat fee payable by the recipient couple to the NEDC at the time of their frozen embryo transfer. Although the amount owed will vary based on how many different donor embryos are thawed per transfer, it is subject to minimums and maximums as outlined below.

Third Multi-Embryo Donor Profile	\$450

The NEDC will NOT charge for more than three Donor Profiles per transfer. *These fees do not apply if you yourself have used that specific donor for a previous transfer*. For multi-embryo sets, the minimum fee per transfer is **\$995**, and the total maximum per transfer is **\$1895**.

Single-Embryo Sets

Second Single-Embryo Donor Profile	\$450
Third Single-Embryo Donor Profile	\$450

The NEDC will NOT charge for more than three Donor Profiles per transfer. *These fees do not apply if you yourself have used that specific donor for a previous transfer.* For single-embryo sets, the minimum fee per transfer is \$450, and the total maximum per transfer is **\$1350.**

For Recipients Using a Combination of Multi-Embryo and Single-Embryo Profiles:

If your primary donor set is a single embryo set and you have a multi-embryo set as a back-up, your primary donor fee will be \$450 and your first multi-embryo back-up fee will be \$995. If a third donor profile is used (single- OR multi-embryo set) that third profile fee will be \$450. The maximum fee for a combination-profile transfer is \$1895.

We may offer a discounted rate for the donor associated fees of select special consideration embryos, to encourage their use. Please contact us if you have an interest in a special consideration donor profile or if you have any questions regarding donor associated fees.

1 Fees paid to the NEDC are non-refundable and administrative in nature, not medical. They are not covered by insurance nor are they eligible expenses for Flexible Spending Accounts or Health Care Spending Accounts.
